

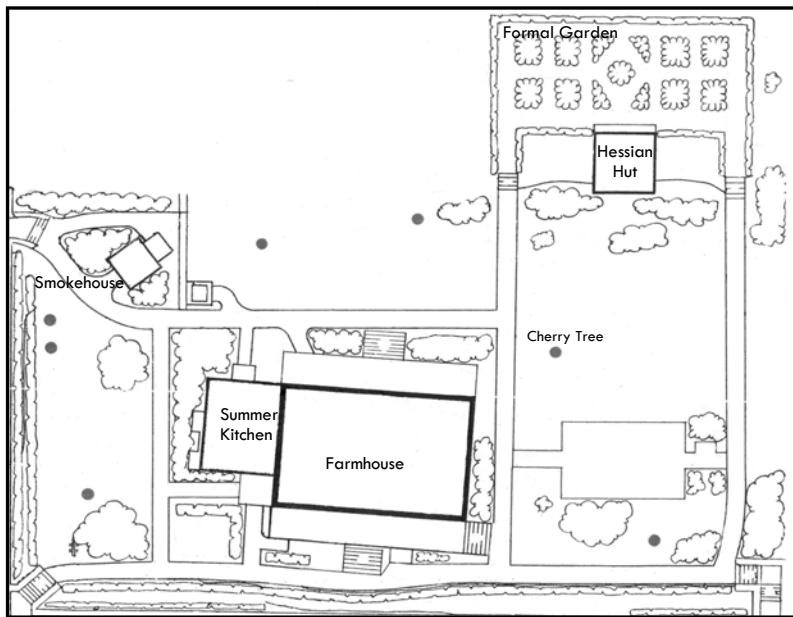
Dyckman Farmhouse Post Visit Activity

Mapping Activity

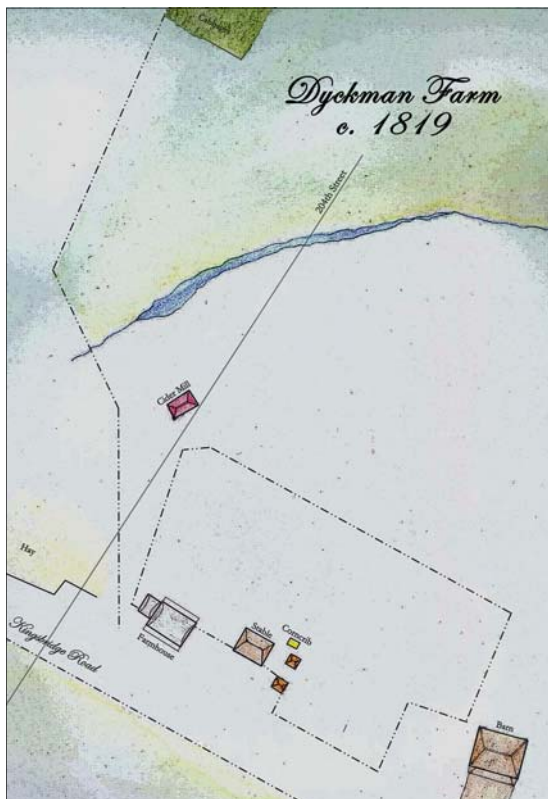
The landscape around the farmhouse has changed quite a bit since the house was built in 1784. Compare the maps of the Farmhouse to see how things have changed over time.

Map A. This is a map from the museum phase of the house, around the year 1916. The grounds had been landscaped, and brick paths were added. The Hessian Military Hut and the reproduction smokehouse were also added at this time.

Map B. This map shows the farmyard around the year 1819. This map shows the buildings that were necessary for farm work and some of the things grown near the house.
